Update to 4400 W. Peoria Ave. Fatality Collision

GLENDALE, Ariz. – At approximately 7:20 PM on 11-14-13 Glendale Police Officers responded to the area of the 4400 block of W. Peoria Ave in regards to a collision involving a pedestrian. Preliminary investigation revealed that a pedestrian was crossing from the north side of Peoria Ave southbound and was not inside of a crosswalk, when he was struck by a westbound vehicle (Jeep). The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.

The Jeep was being driven by a male in his 30's who is a Peoria resident, and was also occupied by his teen-age daughter. Neither speed nor impairment appears to be a factor in this collision on the part of the Jeep driver.

Glendale Police Vehicular Crimes detectives have been working since that evening to notify the family of the pedestrian who was killed in this collision however, have been unable to locate any family members in the Phoenix metropolitan area. The deceased's name is David Digildo, a white male in his 50's, who is believed to be homeless. The Glendale Police Department is asking anyone who is related to David, or anyone who knows of a relative that can be contacted, to please call the non-emergency number (623-930-3000). There are no photos of Mr. Digildo available.
