Update – Suspect in April 1st Glendale Police Shooting Released from Hospital and Booked

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Antoin J Thurman, the suspect that was shot by Glendale Officers after he pointed a handgun at them on April 1st, was released from a valley hospital late Friday and immediately booked into the 4th Avenue Jail by Glendale Detectives.

Thurman was booked for (5) counts of Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, (1) count of Domestic Violence Aggravated Assault on the female he had a relationship with, (1) Count of Aggravated on an additional victim, (2) counts of Threatening and (1) count of Misconduct Involving Weapons.

All four Glendale Officers involved are back at work after the standard administrative leave that comes when involved in a shooting. Attached is photo of Thurman.
