GLENDALE POLICE SEEK FEMALE ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECT

GLENDALE, Ariz. The Glendale Police Department is asking for your help in identifying a female suspect who has committed a series of armed robberies in Glendale and Phoenix.

On 4/30/2009, the woman entered the Chase bank inside the Fry's food store at 20220 N. 59 Ave at approximately 2:00 p.m., displayed a note to a teller indicating she had a gun and demanded money. The woman committed a second robbery at Bank of America, in the Fry's food store at 6655 W. Bell Road on 6/01/2009 at approximately 1:30 p.m. in the same manner. No weapons have been displayed or observed during these robberies. This woman is also believed to have committed similar robberies in the city of Phoenix.

The suspect is described as a white female, 25-30 years of age, 5'0" to 5'3" tall, 175 to 200 lbs, with blonde, brown or reddish orange hair and bright blue eyes. (Please see attached photos) Video surveillance is not available at this time.
