Arrest Made in September Homicide

GLENDALE, Ariz. – On November 17th, 2016, Detectives from the Glendale Police Department arrested two subjects involved in a homicide. 25 year old John Anguiano and 25 year old Angelo Mungia were both charged with 1st Degree Murder, in reference to the shooting of 31 year old Robert Nunez Granado.

On 9-17-16 at 3:20 AM, Glendale Police Officers heard gunshots in the area of N 67 Avenue and W Glendale Avenue. Upon checking the area officers located a group of people in the area of 6700 block of W Palmaire Avenue. A subject was found with a gunshot wound near 6700 W Palmaire Avenue. That subject was pronounced deceased on scene.

Both subjects arrested for the incident were interviewed regarding the situation. John Anguiano admitted to shooting the victim during the incident. After interviews it was determined that both subjects went to a residence in the area. Both subjects were armed. Angelo entered the residence and confronted the occupants of the home, while armed with a firearm. The victim was at a neighbor residence and heard the commotion. As he approached the residence he was fatally shot by John.

Both subjects were charged and being held at Maricopa County Jail.
