CITY COUNCILMEMBER LAUREN TOLMACHOFF NAMED GLENDALE VICE MAYOR

Glendale, Ariz. – Cholla District Councilmember Lauren Tolmachoff has been appointed to serve as the vice mayor of Glendale. The city council selected Tolmachoff for the rotating council position on Tuesday, Jan. 9 during a formal council meeting. As vice mayor, she will be responsible for performing the duties of the mayor during the mayor’s absence. City Council guidelines require councilmembers to nominate candidates for vice mayor each year.

Tolmachoff was elected to Glendale City Council in November 2014 and began her term on December 9, 2014. She serves on the National League of Cities’(NLC) Public Safety and Crime Prevention Committee, NLC’s First Tier Suburbs Committee as vice chair and the Glendale Council Business Sub Committee. She also serves as Glendale’s representative on the Board of Directors for the Valley Metro Regional Public Transportation Authority (RPTA) as vice chair and Valley Metro Rail.

“I’m honored to serve as vice mayor for the city of Glendale,” said Councilmember Lauren Tolmachoff. “I am committed to continue moving the city forward to improve the lives of the residents and businesses that I serve.”
