## **GENERAL ELECTION EARLY BALLOTS AVAILABLE UNTIL FRIDAY**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – The City of Glendale Clerk’s Office reminds registered voters that early ballots for the General Election are available from the Maricopa County Elections Department through this Friday, Oct. 24.

Residents that are registered to vote in the General Election can still request an early ballot through the mail for the Nov. 4 General Election through this Friday, Oct. 24. Residents can also choose to become a permanent early voter by going to the Maricopa County Election Department by clicking [here](#) or calling (602) 506-1511.

Friday, Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 p.m. will be the last day to vote early in the General Election. For an early ballot to be counted in the General Election it must be received (postmarks do not count) by 7 p.m. on Election Day.
