IMPORTANT TRAFFIC INFORMATION FOR UPCOMING CARDINALS GAMES

GLENDALE, Ariz.– With the Arizona Cardinals first regular season home game just around the corner, the city of Glendale wants to advise football fans of important parking and traffic information to ensure the best fan experience possible in the city's vibrant sports and entertainment areas in and around University of Phoenix Stadium.

Know Before You Go!

- **PLAN AHEAD** – know where you are going to park. Follow directions on the back of the parking pass for quickest access to the parking lot and do not rely on GPS for parking lot routes.
- **ARRIVE EARLY** - for easiest arrival experience, arrive at the Stadium during the first two hours of parking lot opening (1:30 pm to 3:30 pm).
- If you do not have a parking pass, follow directions on the dynamic message signs over the freeways and roadways for quickest access to less congested parking lots, and Have Payment Ready Upon Entry To Parking Lot.
- Fans should be alert to pedestrians in walkways and crosswalks, drive safely and obey all temporary traffic signage; in some areas, there are multiple turn lanes (dual rights or dual lefts) to load and unload parking lots faster.

Game Day Traffic Updates

The Glendale Traffic Management Center, in partnership with ADOT, will be monitoring game day traffic and providing real-time traffic management and updates on all game days. Fans can also call **511** for the latest updated traffic information. Glendale Police will also be onsite during peak traffic times to direct traffic and help ensure a safe and steady traffic flow. Multiple dynamic messaging signs will be in place to direct traffic and provide real-time traveler information.

- 95th Ave.: Bethany Home Rd. to Maryland Ave. in front of the University of Phoenix Stadium
- Maryland Ave.: 95th Ave. to 93rd Ave.

Additional Information

- Vehicles are not permitted to stage on city streets prior to lot openings.
- Fans, taxi and limo drivers can download parking maps at www.glendalesgotgame.com.

Acceptable bags include a clear plastic bag (sized 12" x 6" x 12"); a one-gallon plastic freezer bag; or a clutch (with either a shoulder or wrist strap) no larger than 4.5" x 6.5".
