GLENDALE VOTERS URGED TO PREPARE NOW FOR PRIMARY ELECTION

GLENDALE, Ariz. -- The city of Glendale reminds residents that the August 28 primary is approaching fast and Glendale voters will find three City Council races on their primary ballot.

Ray Strahl and Bart Turner are on the ballot for the Barrel District. Lauren Tolmachoff is on the ballot for the Cholla District and for the Ocotillo District voters will choose between Jamie Aldama and Emmanuel Allen.

“We urge voters to take some time prior to the election to make sure they are registered to vote and understand the steps in the process,” said Glendale City Clerk Julie Bower.

Election Schedule and Information:

- **VOTER REGISTRATION**
Voters must be registered by July 30 to be eligible to vote in the primary. Register to vote by stopping by the Glendale City Clerk’s Office, calling the Maricopa County Recorder at 602-506-1511 or visiting <http://servicearizona.com> or <http://recorder.maricopa.gov/elections/>.
- **EARLY BALLOTS**
The Maricopa County Recorder’s Office will begin mailing early ballots on August 1 to voters on the permanent early voter list. To request an early ballot or more information regarding the permanent early voting list, contact the Maricopa County Recorder’s Office at 602-506-1511 or visit: <http://recorder.maricopa.gov/elections/>. The last day to submit a request for an early ballot for the August 28 Primary is August 17.
- **INDEPENDENT VOTERS**
Voters registered as Independent must choose one political party ballot such as the Democratic or Republican party to vote in the primary election. Glendale Independent voters may also choose a ballot with city candidates only. To order a ballot, call the Maricopa County Recorder’s Office at 602-506-1511.
