## **Glendale Police Investigate the Hit and Run Accident involving a Pedestrian**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – \*\*\*Updated\*\*\*On Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at approximately 7:08 PM, Glendale Police responded to an accident involving a pedestrian being struck by a vehicle in the roadway at 59<sup>th</sup> Drive and Glendale Avenue. Witnesses reported that the pedestrian, 67-year-old Kenneth Cahill, was crossing W. Glendale Avenue within a marked crosswalk at 59<sup>th</sup> Drive when struck by a vehicle traveling on Glendale Avenue. Once striking Kenneth, the driver of the vehicle failed to stop and fled the scene westbound on Glendale Avenue.

Kenneth was transported to a local valley hospital, suffering from multiple life-threatening injuries and is currently still receiving emergency treatment as he fights for his life.

The suspect vehicle is described as a dark color sedan. The vehicle should have damage to the front of the vehicle and possibly the windshield from the impact. Please see the attached photo as a vehicle of interest in the hit and run accident. There are no details to release regarding the driver at this time.

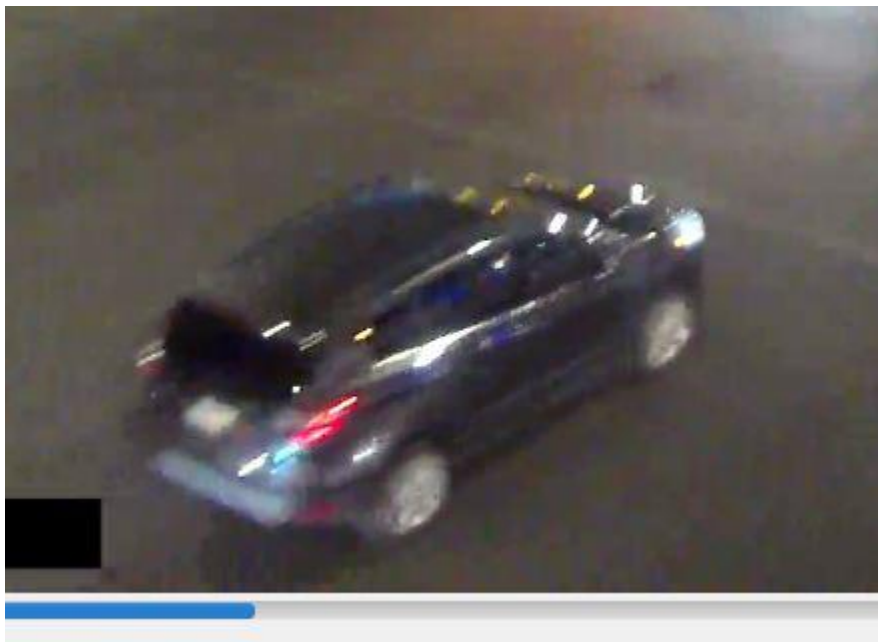
