## **GLENDALE SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT ON DESIGN CONCEPTS FOR THE MARYLAND AVENUE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE CONNECTOR PROJECT**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – The city of Glendale is hosting a public meeting to review design concepts developed for the Maryland Avenue Pedestrian and Bicycle Connector Project. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 11, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Challenger Middle School, 6905 West Maryland Avenue. This project will improve safety and connectivity for pedestrians and bicyclists traveling along Maryland Avenue between 69th and 75th avenues.

### **Project Overview**

The city of Glendale, with a grant from the Maricopa Association of Governments, is developing design concepts for improving pedestrian and bicycle facilities along Maryland Avenue between 69th and 75th avenues. These concepts will also evaluate a pedestrian/bicycle connection to 75th Avenue from where Maryland Avenue currently terminates immediately east of 75th Avenue. Other improvements under evaluation include bike lanes, improved signage, pavement restriping, and pedestrian enhancements at intersections.
