TWO EMMY NOMINATIONS FOR GLENDALE'S TV STATION

GLENDALE, Ariz. – For the fifth year in a row, Glendale 11 TV has received nominations for Rocky Mountain Emmy Awards. Glendale 11 was nominated for programs featuring the city's Major League Baseball (MLB) spring training stadium, Camelback Ranch – Glendale.

The Emmy Awards recognize and reward excellence in television broadcasting. Glendale 11 competed against TV stations, production houses and advertising agencies from five different states.

The two nominations are for “Glendale’s Got Game: The Making of Camelback Ranch-Glendale” and “Opening Day at Camelback Ranch-Glendale.” Both TV shows air on Glendale 11 and segments can also be seen on the city’s You Tube Channel at www.youtube.com/myglendale11.

Glendale 11 is one of only two government TV stations in the region to be nominated for an Emmy this year. Since 2006 the Glendale station has been nominated 15 times and has won two Emmy Awards. This year’s awards ceremony will take place Oct. 9 in Phoenix.
