## FINAL ELECTION REMINDERS FROM THE GLENDALE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale's General Election is Tuesday, November 2 and polling sites will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Polling locations can be found on the city's website at: <a href="www.glendaleaz.com/clerk">www.glendaleaz.com/clerk</a> under 'Upcoming Election Information.' Voters with early ballots that have not been mailed can turn the ballot in to the Maricopa County Elections Office on or before Election Day or bring the ballot to their local polling site on Tuesday.

On election night, the city will provide election results via both Glendale 11 TV and the city website. Residents can tune into Glendale Channel 11 to view a scrolling graphic with updated results from the Maricopa County Elections Department or visit Glendale's website for a link to the county recorder's site for up-to-date results:

www.glendaleaz.com/clerk.

The General Election includes city council seats in two districts: Barrel and Ocotillo. During the Primary Election in August, none of the city council candidates in those districts received 50 percent plus one of the votes necessary to be elected. In the Ocotillo District, the runoff candidates are incumbent David Goulet and Norma Alvarez, and in the Barrel District, the candidates will be incumbent Yvonne Knaack and Anthony Kern. Mildred Ramirez is no longer a write-in candidate in the Barrel District; she officially alerted election officials that she was withdrawing her name.
