**GLENDALE GENERAL ELECTION ONE WEEK AWAY
RESULTS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON TV & ONLINE**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale’s General Election is one week away and the City Clerk’s Office reminds voters that polling sites will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday November 2. Polling locations can be found on the city’s website at:

www.glendaleaz.com/clerk under ‘Upcoming Election Information.’

The General Election includes city council seats in two districts: Barrel and Ocotillo. During the Primary Election in August, none of the city council candidates in those districts received 50 percent plus one of the votes necessary to be elected. In the Ocotillo District, the runoff candidates are incumbent David Goulet and Norma Alvarez, and in the Barrel District, the candidates will be incumbent Yvonne Knaack and Anthony Kern and write-in candidate Mildred Ramirez.

On election night, the city will provide election results via both Glendale 11 TV and the city website. Residents can tune into Glendale Channel 11 to view a scrolling graphic with updated results from the Maricopa County Elections Department or visit Glendale’s website for a link to the county recorder’s site for up-to-date results:
