GLENDALE ANNOUNCES SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING TO APPROVE PRIMARY ELECTION VOTES

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale City Council will hold a special meeting on Tuesday, Sept. 7, at 1 p.m. to officially approve the results from the Aug. 24 Primary Election. Approval of the Primary Election Canvass of Vote Resolution will officially lead to a runoff election on Nov. 2 in the Barrel and Ocotillo districts. During the Primary Election, none of the city council candidates in those districts received 50 percent plus one of the votes necessary to be elected.

In the Ocotillo District, the runoff candidates are incumbent David Goulet and Norma Alvarez, and in the Barrel District, the candidates will be incumbent Yvonne Knaack and Anthony Kern.

Final tabulation from the Maricopa County Elections Department includes:

Ocotillo District:

- David Goulet – 34.36% (738 votes)
- Norma Alvarez – 33.75% (725 votes)
- Bob Bohart – 22.86% (491 votes)
- Bud Zomok – 8.75% (188 votes)
- Write-In Candidate 0.28% (6 votes)

Total Votes: 2,148

Barrel District:

- Yvonne Knaack – 49.55% (2,448 votes)
- Anthony Kern – 28.20% (1,393 votes)
- “Mickey” Lillian Lund – 21.84% (1,079 votes)
- Write-In Candidate – 0.40% (20 votes)

Total Votes: 4,940

In the Cholla District, Manuel “Manny” Martinez ran unopposed and received 97.44 percent and 5,252 votes. For more information on the upcoming
