RESIDENTS ARE INVITED TO HELP DESIGN NEW BIKE PARK AT PUBLIC MEETING SEPTEMBER 12

Glendale, Ariz. -- The city of Glendale is inviting all bike enthusiasts to provide input on the design of a new bike park at a public meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 12, at 5:30 p.m., at Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center, 5600 W. Union Hills Dr. The bike park will be located within Foothills Park, at the northeast corner of 59th Avenue and Union Hills Drive.

Glendale Parks and Recreation staff will be joined by American Ramp Company, who is contracted to design and build the bike park. The meeting will allow the public an opportunity to be part of discussions about the various types of bike parks and riding styles, as well as what would serve the community best and be the best fit at Foothills Park. Residents attending the meeting will have the opportunity to look at design concepts and ask questions of city staff and American Ramp Company.
