**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Have an old phone just lying around? Donate it during the month of November in Glendale, and your donation will benefit victims of domestic violence.

In celebration of America Recycles Day on Nov. 1, the city of Glendale will again hold its annual cell phone recycling program, with collection points at the following locations:

- Gila River Arena, 9400 W. Maryland Ave. (northwest corner Gate 3)
- Glendale Community College, 6000 W. Olive Ave., Office A-57 (northwest corner of the administration building)
- Glendale Visitor Center, 5800 W. Glenn Dr. suite 140
- Glendale's three public libraries:
  - Main Library, 5959 W. Brown Rd.
  - Foothills Library, 19055 N. 57th Ave.
  - Velma Teague Library, 7010 N. 58th Ave.

All phones collected will be refurbished and available for victims of stalking and domestic violence, through the Glendale Family Advocacy Center (GFAC). The goal of the GFAC is to provide comprehensive and coordinated services to crime victims in a safe, comfortable and convenient setting.

The one-stop center is a partnership between the Glendale Police Department, A New Leaf, Child Protective Services, Scottsdale Health Care, Phoenix Children's Hospital and the Maricopa County Attorney's Office, and includes facilities for forensic interviews, medical examinations, counseling and collaboration between law enforcement and victim services personnel. It is designed for victims of violence, child abuse and sex-related crimes, the center is available for crime victims and law enforcement agencies throughout the West Valley.

“While Glendale promotes recycling, mobile phones are not part of our curbside program. This event gives people an opportunity to keep phones out of the landfill and help people who need a vital link to those who can help them in a crisis,” said Deb Coy, recycling coordinator for the city of Glendale.

America Recycles Day is the only nationally-recognized day dedicated to promoting and celebrating recycling in the US. Thousands of events are held across the U.S. to raise awareness about the importance of recycling and to encourage American to sign personal pledges to recycle and buy products made from recycled materials.
