## **EVERY DOG HAS HIS DAY AT THE 8TH ANNUAL DOG DAYS OF GLENDALE IN MURPHY PARK MARCH 24**

Glendale, Ariz. -- Hot dog! Dog Days of Glendale -Woof Fest 2018 will transform Historic Downtown Glendale's town square into Murphy "Bark," as hundreds of dogs and their humans are invited to enjoy a canine-centric event on Saturday, March 24, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Midwestern University is this year's "Top Dog" sponsor and will have their Ambulatory Unit designed for large animals on site for attendees to check out, along with information about their Companion Animal Clinic Services. The interactive festivities will include: low cost immunizations from Dr. Kelly Mobile Vet; an opportunity to meet Ranger – Glendale's Park & Recreation Community Outreach Dog, which is the first program of its kind in the nation; Bark Busters Phoenix Goodyear presents 'Woof Games,' a fun activity area for you and your dog; a training demo from Glendale's Police K9; Pratt's Pet and Feed providing a variety of product and food samples; City of Glendale Parks & Recreation "Walk a Hound-Lose a Pound" walking map challenge and giveaways; Run Buddy Mobile, a climate-controlled van offering canine exercise service brought right to your door; PinkHoney Candles, paw-shaped handmade vegan, cruelty-free, phthalate- and dye-free soy candles that are locally made; as well as Papa Ed's Ice Cream Free Frosty Paw frozen treats for the first 300 dogs. Dog Days of Glendale will also feature more than 40 pet-related vendors, a photo booth, canine demonstrations and much more.

This year, the event is raising funds and collecting pet food and supplies to benefit "Animals in Disaster - Empty Bowl Pet Food Pantry," a non-profit group striving to help humans and animals through disastrous situations.
