GLENDALE COUNCILMEMBER SHERWOOD SPOTLIGHTS WILDLIFE WORLD ZOO ON “GLENDALE TODAY”

Glendale, Ariz. — Glendale Councilmember Gary Sherwood, Sahuaro District, tours the West Valley’s Wildlife World Zoo in his new edition of the TV show “Glendale Today”. The show highlights the zoo’s newest attraction, the 15 acre “Safari Park”. Zoo director and founder Mickey Ollson takes CM Sherwood on a tram ride through the new enclosures for an up close and personal look at more than 30 different African animals including wildebeest, spider monkeys and warthogs.

Ollson discusses the history of the Wildlife World Zoo, how much it has grown and future plans for the undeveloped portions of the property located near the Loop 303 and Northern Parkway. CM Sherwood also joins in on some of the most popular zoo attractions, feeding the giraffes and holding a baby jaguar and a baby warthog! A future show this fall is planned to highlight the zoo’s aquarium and sea life.

The show begins airing July 4 at 8 p.m. “Glendale Today” is produced by staff from the city-owned TV station Glendale 11.
