## **PRESIDENTS DAY HOLIDAY NOTICE** *City Office Hours and Schedule Changes*

**GLENDALE, Arizona** -- City of Glendale offices will be closed Monday, Feb. 18, in observance of Presidents Day.

All residential garbage and recycling collection services, commercial services and bulk trash will take place as usual on all regularly scheduled collection days throughout the holiday week, however the Glendale Municipal Landfill will be closed Feb. 18 in observance of the holiday. Only Gus Bus One will run Monday, Feb. 18, operating on a normal weekday schedule. Reservations for Dial-a-Ride service for the weekend preceding the holiday and the observed federal holiday (Monday, Feb. 18), must be made ahead of time – by noon Friday, Feb. 15. Reservations can be made by calling Glendale’s Transit Services at 623-930-3500. No same-day service will be available Monday, Feb. 18. ADA service will be available and will be based on a normal weekday fixed route schedule. Valley Metro buses and light rail will operate on a normal weekday schedule.

While the Glendale Municipal Airport will remain open during the holiday, the airport’s administrative offices and Glendale’s three public libraries will be closed Monday, Feb. 18, along with the Visit Glendale offices.
