## SKUNK CREEK PARK MAINTENANCE AND CLEARING PROJECT

**Glendale, Ariz.** —The Skunk Creek Linear Park Vegetation Maintenance and Clearing Project, extending from N. 51st Ave. to N. 73rd Ave., officially commenced last week.

The project's focus is to address Skunk Creek's vegetation maintenance and clearing of the park channel bed and side slopes. Specifically, the operation is to clear and prune vegetation such as trees, shrubs and ground cover plants. All roots from the vegetation will remain in the ground to minimize disturbance, so that no structural repair, rehabilitation or replacement occurs. Additionally, there will be no grading or sediment removal taking place.

“Working together with city engineers, budget and finance and our parks staff, we have been able to create a scope of work, engage a contractor and receive an allocation for the funding needed to complete the project in the 2018-2019 fiscal year budget,” said Councilmember Lauren Tolmachoff. “Staff has also calculated the ongoing cost for the maintenance of Skunk Creek Wash, and that cost will be included in the annual budget process going forward.”
