10th season of spring training starts next Friday

GLENDALÉ, Ariz. – The city of Glendale will celebrate the start of spring training in the Valley of the Sun on Saturday, Feb. 23, when the Chicago White Sox take on the Los Angeles Dodgers at 1:05 p.m. at Camelback Ranch-Glendale, 10710 W. Camelback Rd.

To help out baseball fans headed to the ballpark and alleviate game day traffic congestion between Loop 101 and the ballpark, Glendale Traffic Management Center experts have mapped out a special travel route just for days when heavy attendance is expected.

Special Game Day Traffic Route for fans traveling between Loop 101 & Camelback Ranch!
Loop 101 traffic- Exit onto westbound Glendale Ave. and follow “GLENDALÉ BASEBALL COMPLEX” special event route traffic signs. Motorists will be guided south onto El Mirage Rd. and then left onto Camelback Rd. and continue eastward to the ballpark. After the game, the route will be reversed and Loop 101-bound traffic will be routed westbound on Camelback Rd., to northbound El Mirage Rd., to eastbound Glendale Ave., to Loop 101.

The 2018 spring training games marks the 10th season at Camelback Ranch and runs Feb. 23 through March 25. Glendale will once again feature promotions this season, such as Family Sundays and the Senior Stroll every Wednesday.
