FIREFIGHTERS HOSTING FIRST ANNUAL TURKEY DRIVE

Glendale, Ariz. — Glendale’s Hope for Hunger Food Bank, the first firefighter ran food bank in the country, is hosting its first annual Turkey Drive this Saturday, November 8, at Ranch Market located at 6730 West Camelback Road in Glendale. Volunteers will be on hand to accept turkeys as well as canned goods from 8 a.m. until 2 p.m.

Hope For Hunger Food Bank provides emergency food assistance to those in need and is now serving residents in Glendale and some parts of Peoria and Phoenix. The food bank was founded in 2011 by Glendale Firefighters, opened its doors to serve the community in May 2012, and completed its first full year in 2013. There was an astounding increase of 57% when comparing 17,000 families in 2012 to 39,700 families in 2013. This is 146,000 men, women, and children impacted in 2013, up from 61,000 in 2012.
