DISPOSAL RATES

STANDARD FEE

Glendale residents (FIRST 2,000 LBS – NO FEE) Weight over 2,000 lbs is	\$15.79 per ton (\$0.79/100 lbs.)
Avondale residents	\$27.50 per ton (\$1.38/100 lbs.)
Peoria residents.....	\$25.00 per ton (\$1.25/100lbs.)
All other landfill customers	\$32.25 per ton (\$1.61/100 lbs.)

TIRES

Glendale residents	(Tires w/o rims-up to 5).....	NO CHARGE
Avondale and Peoria residents	(Tires w/o rims-up to 5).....	\$3.00 per tire
All other landfill customers.....	TIRES ARE NOT ACCEPTED	

FREON

Refrigerators/freezers/ water coolers/A/C units, etc\$15.00 PER ITEM

HARD TO HANDLE WASTE

.....\$131.25 per ton (\$6.56/100 lbs.)
Items measuring four feet long or two feet in diameter may be charged at this rate. This specifically includes stumps, trees, concrete and other solid items.

CHECK POLICY: *Company checks only NO OUT OF STATE CHECKS ACCEPTED*

ACCEPTABLE WASTE TYPES

- Non-liquid municipal solid waste - garbage, trash, and other wastes from households, commercial or industrial facilities. Unwashed and sealed drums are prohibited.
- Construction debris from demolition and construction activities.
- Yard Clippings - grass, leaves, trees.
- Animals - pets only.
- Dry sewage sludge from wastewater treatment plants (upon review and approval of analytical and paint filter test results).
- Pesticide containers (punctured and rinsed at least three (3) times).
- Non-infectious medical waste- residents must place medical sharps into a hard plastic container and place container into a dark plastic bag before disposing. Autoclaved sickroom waste - all sickroom waste must have supporting documentation. (No hypodermic needles or other sharp objects from hospitals, clinics, laboratories, dentist, etc.)
- Household hazardous waste (HHW): Limited to hazardous waste from households. This includes paint & stains, antifreeze, motor oil, filters & other automotive fluids, pool chemicals, household chemicals & pesticides. ALL liquids MUST be contained in the original container and/or marked to identify its contents).
- Flammable liquids will be accepted from residential customers only. Commercial customers may not dispose of any flammable liquids.
- Travel trailers, boats, and motorcycles will be accepted under the following conditions: You must present a clear title, free of liens, and a matching driver’s license. All fluids must be removed, and all propane tanks must be empty.
- Empty propane tanks

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

- Automobiles - including trucks, bodies, and frames.
- Batteries and tires – Glendale, Avondale and Peoria residents are allowed 5 tires **without rims** per load.
- Asbestos - friable and non-friable.
- Septage - pumpage from septic tanks.
- Petroleum contaminated soil.
- Industrial and commercial process wastes - liquid and solids.
- Hazardous waste – household hazardous waste from commercial haulers.
- Incinerator ash
- Infectious medical waste - including waste blood, serum, plasma, blood products, contaminated hypodermic needles, syringes, scalpel blades, or sharps from hospitals, clinics, laboratories, dentist, etc.

CITY OF GLENDALE RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLABLES

Paper: Newspaper, including advertising inserts - no rubber bands, plastic bags, etc.

Mixed paper - magazines, junk mail, catalogs.

Brown paper bags, cartons - half gallon milk or juice cartons, chipboard - cereal, cracker and cake mix boxes without inserts.

Aluminum: Soda, beer cans

Cardboard: Boxes empty of all packing material

Plastic:

PET or #1 plastics - water bottles & two liter soda bottles - look for #1 on the bottom of item

HDPE or #2 plastics - milk jugs, detergent & fabric softener bottles - look for #2 on the bottom of item

Steel/Tin:

Steel/tin - soup or vegetable cans - lightly rinsed

E-WASTE DROP-OFF SITE

The types of electronic items that will be accepted are: personal computers, laptop and notebook computers, central processing units (CPU's), keyboards and mice, flat screen monitors, circuit boards, hard drives, other computer drives (floppy, CD-ROM, Zip, etc.), software, printers, copiers, scanners, fax machines, external storage devices, modems, typewriters, calculators, adding machines, telephones, cell phones, answering machines, pagers, flat screen televisions, videocassette recorders (VCRs), stereo equipment, speakers, cameras, radios, and video game systems.

The city of Glendale no longer accepts Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) televisions, monitors or rear projection televisions.

RECYCLABLE GLASS DROP-OFF SITE (ALL COLORS)

Glass is not collected through the Curbside Recycling Program; however, it may be taken to the Materials Recovery Facility located at 11480 W. Glendale Avenue (same as Landfill location) and placed in the drop off bin marked "GLASS ONLY".

(Note: **BEVERAGE BOTTLES ONLY.** These types of glass are not accepted: window glass, mirrors, ceramics, light bulbs, glassware, etc.)
